**LOCATION:** Birch Coulee Arena, Morton, MN

**FEES:** \$10 per rig for two nights camping

**BACKGROUND:** This Ride will benefit Majestic Hill Ranch, Therapeutic riding for children with special needs located in Lakeville, MN and Free Winds Equine Assisted growth and Learning Program in Richmond, MN.

**ITINERARY:** Camp will open on Friday at 1 p.m. followed with a short ride beginning 5:30 pm. Saturday morning ride will leave base camp at 9 a.m. and return at 3:30 p.m. Riders need to pack a lunch. Return for ranch sorting, dinner and silent auction. Sunday we will ride at 10am -12pm.
